- Warrant was signed.
- Minutes for 6/7/10 were approved.
- Tom noted a complaint made by Walter Kurkulonis who wanted the Board to take note of the safety conditions of the bridge in South Shirkshire. The Board discussed their recollection of the location and status of this bridge. His complaint was duly noted.
- The Board signed the stipend forms for semi-annual and annual payments.
- The Board authorized Maureen to sign the Weston & Sampson contract for the South River project.
- The Board authorized the release of the Freitas Construction bid deposit that will be sent to Weston & Sampson.
- The Board approved the list of re-appointments presented, with the exception of the CIPC, who will attend the next meeting (see attached). They also did not re-appoint the Festival of the Hills and Housing Committee nominees until there is further clarification.
- The Board approved the 4th of July parade.
- The Board requested continued disbursement of the dispatch map from the Assessors office.
- The Board denied a request for a new coffee maker for the staff.
- Chuck asked about the Kuzmeskus site visit. Maureen and Bob Baker had attended on Saturday morning. Maureen described the physical aspects of the problem, including a request for a culvert that would drain onto the Perkarski's land. Jim suggested that the Conservation Commission be consulted. Bob Baker's felt that the problem was not the Town's responsibility as the road had been in its current condition for years. Chuck suggested that Brian should be told that the situation was under review and that Bob would be asked for more information. Chuck will follow up with Bob on this for next week's meeting.
- There was a brief discussion about a letter from the Mass School Building Association. After a review it was determined that Conway did not qualify for funding through this program. Tom will follow up with the MSBA to confirm this.
- There was a discussion about the Planning Board.
