Appointments

Elizabeth Braccia – Financial borrowing for the grammar school project was discussed. Elizabeth explained that the short term bond was due on October 30th. She would find out when money from the MSBA will arrive and that will determine how much and when the bond will be paid back. She elaborated how timing could be utilized and amounts that could be paid. This was based on the information she had collected from the Town's financial advisor.

meeting items

- warrant was signed.
- Chuck reported on his meeting with the other 4 Towns group (Deerfield, Sunderland and Whately) with regard to regionalizing goods and services. There was a brief discussion of the advantages of this planning. Chuck noted how he had come to realize the potential benefits of this type of local arrangement and urged the Board to consider sharing costs with neighboring Towns in the future.
- Chuck mentioned how Bob Rodovich had been contacting him on a regular basis. He said that he told Bob that he would no longer be available to consult on his personal matter. Bob should not contact Town officials for advise because all that could be done had been done.
- Tom will research if Richard Farrick would be willing to sell his property at 22 Academy Hill Road to the Town. Lee Whitcomb has advised this purchase to be considered for the purpose of expanded parking facilities, and Tom added that the Board consider expanded storage space as well.
- Tom informed the Board that the Community Preservation Committee will be requesting a Special Town Meeting before this year's Annual Town Meeting to establish a new Bylaw that will officially and legally establish the Committee. The Board requested an official request be given to them from the current Committee. Tom will advise the Committee of this request.
- Chuck suggested that Bob clear the sidewalks of snow on a semi-regular basis this winter. This will be for the purpose of gauging whether the Town will vote to purchase equipment for this purpose in place of rentals from Orchard Equipment.
