### The Conway Board of Health

According to the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, measles, a highly contagious airborne virus, continues to circulate in Massachusetts. Complications can include bronchitis and pneumonia. This year, 24 cases of measles have been confirmed so far in the Commonwealth, compared to three cases for all of 2010. Cases continue to be reported into October. Schools are back in session and it is still early in the season. Conway's Board of Health and the DPH strongly urge adults and children over one year old who have not yet been vaccinated to obtain inoculations through their doctors or health care providers as soon as possible.
